The existing pavement and storm drainage system is in disrepair. Additionally, the grades south of the interchange cause a site distance problem. The roadway and storm drainage system will be removed and reconstructed in their entirety.

## Project Description

Reconstruct existing roadway and storm drainage system. This project was incorporated into the Johnson County Gateway Interchange and will be managed by KDOT. 


